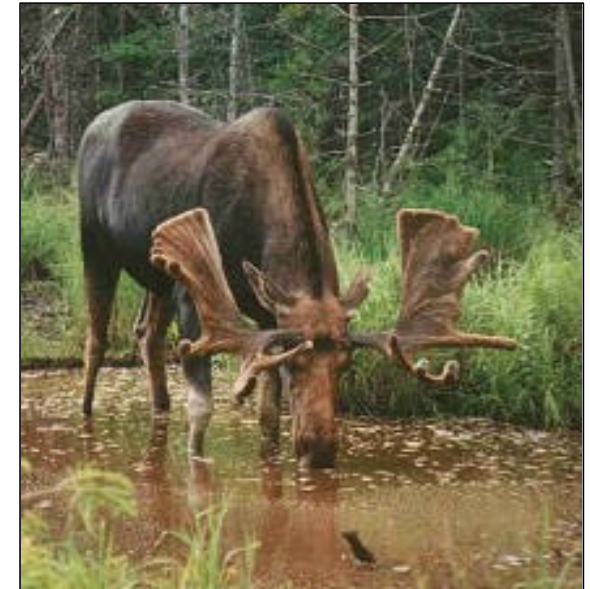

3 Day Canoe/Hike Adventures

Our 3 day canoe hike is an exciting adventure for those who want a taste of paddling as well as the opportunity to get a little closer to nature. Over the course of the hike we will cover approximately 15 kilometres and we stop along the way to admire rocky creeks, rest on cliff tops, swim in clear lakes, and take note of wildflowers, mushrooms, and animal tracks. Don't forget to bring your camera because there is plenty of unforgettable scenery!

4 & 5 Day Canoe Adventures

People with a sense of adventure will love these trips! They are geared towards people who want more than a taste of the Canadian wilderness. These trips run midweek thereby avoiding much of the crowds found on busier weekend routes. We will paddle across many lakes, portage forest trails, swim in clear, clean waters, cook by a fire, and sleep in tents under the stars! The 5 day trips are more vigorous, and are great for more adventurous paddlers.

5 Day Barron Canyon Adventure

This is one of the most spectacular regions of the Park. We begin on the east side of the Park (near Pembroke). It is centred on the Barron Canyon, a spectacular gorge that was formed over 10,000 years ago by a river that carried a thousand times more water than the Niagara River! A series of lakes lead us past waterfalls, rapids, and finally a dramatic canyon lined with 100 metre high cliffs!

8 Day Ontario Adventure

This is the ultimate 8 day adventure! It combines a half day of ATV driving, 5 days of wilderness canoeing in Algonquin Park, and ends with two days of white water rafting down the mighty Ottawa River! After this 8 day adventure, you can definitely say that you have answered the Call Of The Wild!



Killarney Park Canoe/Hike Adventures

Called the "Crown Jewel" of Ontario Parks, Killarney's crystal clear waters are a truly marvellous paddling experience. The millennia old mountain range provides a beautiful backdrop for camping and canoeing, as well as offering excellent trails for "Ridge Walking". This is one of our favourite adventures!
